CALL TO ORDER

Mayor Busby called the town council meeting to order at approximately 7:20 P.M., with Councilmembers McMillan, Davis and Wells present.

Councilmember Davis led those assembled in prayer.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

1. June 13, 2006 Scheduled Council Meeting

Councilmember Davis made a motion that the minutes of June 13, 2006 be approved as submitted. Councilmember McMillan seconded the motion, which was unanimously approved.

OLD BUSINESS

1. Second Reading of revised Town Code

Councilmember agreed on the motion made by the Mayor to accept the second reading of the revised Town Code, with a wording change suggested by Mayor Busby during the work session on Section 4-102 to reflect:

The Finance Committee shall prepare and submit a proposed balanced annual budget to council not later than the fifteenth day of May. A budget summary shall be included which itemizes principal sources of revenue, estimated expenditures by departments, and capital project estimates for the budget. Unexpended funds shall not be carried over by a department, but may be included in revenue estimates for the next budget.

2. Pine Ridge Neighborhood Festival

Council discussed sponsors, banners, vendors and various events planned for weekend of the Festival.

The Mayor made a motion to add the Department of Juvenile Justice letter to the Agenda under New Business, Councilmember Davis agreed. The motion was seconded by Councilmember Wells, which was unanimously approved.

NEW BUSINESS

1. Department of Juvenile Justice(DJJ) letter

The Mayor stated to Council that the Town had received a letter from DJJ requesting an additional Twenty-five dollar per day increase per juvenile. Councilmember Davis made a motion to approve, Councilmember Wells seconded the motion, which was unanimously approved.

With no further business to discuss, Councilman Davis moved to adjourn, Councilman Wells seconded the motion, and with council=s unanimous approval, Mayor Busby adjourned the meeting at 7:50 P.M.
