CALL TO ORDER

Mayor Busby called the Town Council meeting to order at 6:56 P.M. with Mayor Pro-tem Davis, Councilman Dinkins and Price present.

Mr. Carl Kitchens asked Council to look into the sinking hole on Brookfield Drive. Town Clerk, Ms. Moak stated that this has been reported to Lexington County last year and their reply was that the dip in the road was to help with stormwater runoff. Mayor Busby will be meeting with Lexington County on another matter and will bring this to their attention. Mr. Kitchens also spoke regarding the proposed trail and keeping the creek clean.
