  - c) Sidewalk repairs - Councilman Wells will mark sidewalk areas needing repair and contact a local vendor to get cost estimates. Mayor Busby would like Council to consider scheduling a work day to take care of some of the sidewalk issues.

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- e) Town Hall/Police Department - Council discussed the possibility of a new town hall and will be looking for a list of "wants" for space and features from Police Chief Anderson and Town Clerk Viki Moak in the next two weeks. Councilman Wells will be the project coordinator. Next step will be to decide what exactly will be needed in terms of space. After that a public notice for an architect, with a prebid conference for all interested parties. Mayor Pro-tem Davis will look over financials to see what is available.
