- 2) Sewer system throughout town
- 3) Town Hall/Police Department - acquisition and renovations
- 4) Sidewalk Pedestrian Plan with additions down Pine Ridge Drive to future ballfield and Bachman Road
- 5) Walking trail behind Town Hall - purchase and construction
- 6) Camp Moore/Styx Historical Park - purchase

The second meeting on December 5, 2013 has been cancelled as this list of projects will go to Council on December 10, 2013 for approval to get a head start on the estimated cost of the projects that we do not already have numbers for.
